IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-one, chapter twenty-seven, Revised Statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

n Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section twenty-one, chapter twenty-seven,

- 2 Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by inserting
- 3 after the words "and no other" in lines sixth and
- 4 seventh the words 'provided, that no such agent
- 5 shall be appointed in any city, town or plantation
- 6 in which there is one or more apothecaries regis-
- 7 tered under the provisions of section three, chapter
 - 8 twenty-eight, Revised Statutes, unless the town at
 - 9 its annual meeting shall otherwise determine,' so
- 10 that said section as amended shall read as follows:
- 11 'The selectmen of any town and mayor and alder-

12 men of any city may, on the first Monday of May, 13 annually, or as soon thereafter as convenient, buy 14 such quantity of intoxicating liquors as is neces-15 sary to be sold under this chapter, and may appoint 16 some suitable person agent of said town or city to 17 sell the same at some convenient place therein, to 18 be used for medicinal, mechanical and manufac-19 turing purposes, and no other; provided, that no 20 such agent shall be appointed in any city, town or 21 plantation in which there is one or more apothe-22 caries registered under the provisions of section 23 three, chapter twenty-eight, Revised Statutes, 24 unless the town at its annual meeting shall other-25 wise determine; such agent shall receive such 26 compensation for his services, and in the sale of 27 such liquors shall conform to such regulations, not 28 inconsistent with law, as the board appointing him 29 prescribes, and shall hold his situation for one 30 year, unless sooner removed by them or their suc-Vacancies occurring during the year 31 cessors. 32 shall be filled in the same manner as original ap-33 pointments are made. No such agent shall have 34 any interest in such liquors or in the profits of the 35 sale thereof. He may sell intoxicating liquors to 36 such municipal officers to be by them disposed of in 37 accordance with this chapter.'
