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STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend section one hundred and thirty-  
six of chapter eighty-two of the Revised Statutes  
relating to Taxation of Costs.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section one hundred and thirty-six of chapter  
2 eighty-two of the Revised Statutes is hereby  
3 amended by striking out the words "and his de-  
4 cision is final" and inserting instead thereof the  
5 following words: 'And either party dissatisfied  
6 with his taxation may appeal to the court or to a  
7 judge in vacation, from whose decision no appeal  
8 shall be taken, and all attachments shall continue  
9 in force for thirty days after such appeal is  
10 decided.'
