STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section eighty-eight of chapter
forty-nine of the Revised Statutes, relating to In-
surance Companies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section eighty-eight of chapter forty-nine of the
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking
3 out the word "takes," in the fourth line, and in-
4 serting in place thereof the word 'issues,' so that
5 said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'SECT. 88. Every foreign insurance company
7 doing business in this State, shall annually pub-
8 lish, three weeks successively, in some daily or
9 weekly paper printed in every county where it has
10 a duly authorized agent, or issues policies, a con-

11 densed statement of its condition conformable to
12 its last annual report to the Commissioner; and
13 any such insurance company which neglects or
14 refuses to publish such statement, forfeits not less
15 than fifty dollars.'
