IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

House Amendment "B" to Senate Document No. 124.

In section twenty-one, page two, line ten, strike
2 out the words, "and fifty cents," so that said sec-
3 tion shall read as follows:

'SECT. 21. Each commissioner shall receive two
5 dollars a day while actually employed in the ser-
6 vice of the county, including the time spent in
7 travelling, for which every commissioner shall
8 have eight cents a mile for the distance actually
9 travelled, but no commissioner shall have more
10 than one travel during the same hearing or ses-
11 sion, or for more than two adjournments of any
12 regular term; nor for service or travel on more
13 than one petition or case at the same time; nor

14 anything for travel or attendance at the Legisla-
 15 ture connected with the annual county estimates,
 16 nor for any additional trouble or expense.'
