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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-FIVE.

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AN ACT relating to Corporations and Record of  
Damages in Organization thereof.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Whenever a corporation shall make  
2 a change in its charter or certificate of organization,  
3 in any manner, for the more convenient transaction  
4 of its business, it shall forward a notice of such  
5 change to the Secretary of State, who shall record  
6 the same in a book kept for that purpose, and for  
7 making such record, the corporation shall pay the  
8 Secretary of State for his services five dollars in  
9 advance; said fee not to be within the provisions  
10 of section 38 of chapter 2 of the Revised Statutes.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
