STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to Corporations and Record of Damages in Organization thereof.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Whenever a corporation shall make

- 2 a change in its charter or certificate of organization,
- 3 in any manner, for the more convenient transaction
- 4 of its business, it shall forward a notice of such
- 5 change to the Secretary of State, who shall record
- 6 the same in a book kept for that purpose, and for
- 7 making such record, the corporation shall pay the
- 8 Secretary of State for his services five dollars in
- 9 advance; said fee not to be within the provisions
- 10 of section 38 of chapter 2 of the Revised Statutes.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
