## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND-EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to change the time of holding the terms of the Supreme Judicial Court in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1 After the first day of April in the pres-

- 2 ent year, the supreme judicial court, within and
- 3 for the county of Oxford, shall be holden at Paris
- 4 in said county, on the second Tuesday of October,
- 5 and on the second Tuesday of February, annually,
- 6 instead of at the times as now provided by law.
- 7 And in addition to the above named terms, the
- 8 same court shall be held annually hereafter, by
- 9 one of the justices thereof, at said Paris, on the
- 10 first Tuesday of May, which last named term shall
- 11 be held without either grand or traverse jury,

12 unless otherwise specially ordered by any judge of 13 said court. All recognizances and other criminal 14 processes, made returnable to, and to have day in said 15 May term, when no criminal business is transacted, 16 shall be continued to, and have day in, the next 17 term of said court, held in said county.

Sect. 2. All matters pending in, or returnable 2 to, said court, and which would, but for the provi-3 sions of this act, have day at the term of said 4 court to be held on the third Tuesday of Septem-5 ber of the present year as provided by law, shall 6 be returnable to, and have day at, the term of said 7 court to be held on the second Tuesday of October. 8 And all matters pending in, or returnable to, said 9 court, and which would, but for the provision of 10 this act, have day at the term of said court, to be held 11 on the second Tuesday of March, A. D., one thou-12 sand eight hundred and eighty-six, as by law pro-13 vided, shall be returnable to, and have day at the 14 term of said court to be held on the second Tues-15 day of February, A. D. one thousand eight hun-16 dred and eighty-six.
