STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Saint Elizabeth's Catholic
Orphan Asylum of Portland.

Resolved, That the sum of eight hundred dollars
2 be, and hereby is, appropriated for the benefit of
3 the Saint Elizabeth's Orphan Asylum of Portland,
4 and the support of soldiers' and sailors' orphans
5 therein; of which there shall be paid the sum of
6 four hundred dollars in the year eighteen hundred
7 and eighty-five, and the sum of four hundred
8 dollars in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-
9 six.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

During the year 1884, the corporation has cared for 75 children, with very little assistance from relatives, or from father or mother when such were living. Of these 75 children, 14 were returned after a time to friends or relatives; 5 were adopted by respectable families; 39 remain in a succursal building at North Whitefield, for the benefit of country air and more abundant opportunities of exercise.
