STATE OF MAINE.

AN ACT to Incorporate the Frost Brook Dam Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Charles H. Davis, Joseph F. Smith,
2 John F. Whitcomb, Charles H. Haynes, Frederick
3 E. Hartshorn and Ambrose W. Ellis, their heirs,
4 associates and assigns, are hereby created a cor-
5 porate body by the name of the Frost Brook Dam
6 Company, with all the rights and privileges of sim-
7 ilar corporations.

SECT. 2. Said company may erect and maintain
2 a dam on Frost brook, on their own land, in the
3 town of Mariaville, on the site where their dam
4 now is, for the purpose of raising a head of water
5 to drive logs and other lumber and wood.

SECT. 3. Said company may demand and receive
2 as a toll, the sum of twenty cents for every thou-
3 sand feet of logs, board measure, woods scale, and
4 fifteen cents per cord, woods measure, on all stave,
5 shingle or other wood which may pass over said
6 dam, and the said company shall have a lien on
7 logs, stave wood, or other wood which may pass
8 over said dam until the full amount of toll on all
9 logs and wood is paid, but the logs or wood of
10 each particular mark shall only be holden to pay
11 the toll of such mark, and if said toll is not paid
12 within twenty days after said logs or wood, or a
13 major part thereof, shall arrive in Union river,
14 said company may sell at public auction in Ells-
15 worth, after ten days' notice in some paper printed
16 in Ellsworth, so much of said logs or wood as may
17 be necessary to pay said toll and incidental charges.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
