IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to Incorporate the Plantation of Alleguash,
in the County of Aroostook.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The townships in Aroostook county
2 numbered sixteen and seventeen in the tenth range,
3 sixteen and seventeen in the eleventh range, be and
4 are hereby incorporated into a plantation, by the
5 name of Alleguash, having all the powers of towns
6 in relation to laying out, building and repairing of
7 roads and bridges; raising and collecting of money
8 by taxation for the following purposes, to wit: the
9 making and repairing roads and bridges, building
10 and repairing school houses, and the support of
11 schools and plantation purposes.

SECT. 2. The plantation is hereby exempt from
2 state and county tax until eighteen hundred ninety-
3 one. William Dickey or A. G. Fenlason, or either
4 them, are authorized to call the first meeting for
5 the organization of said plantation by posting up
6 two warrants in said plantation seven days prior
7 to the meeting in the month of March or April
8 following the approval of this act and make return
9 of the organization of said plantation to the secre-
10 tary of state.
