STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT in favor of the town of Embden, relating
to Retirement of Town Bonds issued in aid of
Somerset Railroad.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The town of Embden is hereby
2 authorized to retire, by purchase or exchange, the
3 bonds issued by said town in aid of the Somerset
4 Railroad Company, either at or before maturity
5 thereof; and for this purpose to issue town orders
6 or new bonds, in such form and amount, having
7 such rate of interest, and payable at such times
8 and places, as may be determined by vote of the
9 qualified voters of said town at a meeting thereof,
10 called according to law for that purpose; *provided,*

11 *however*, that nothing herein contained shall au-
12 thorize any increase in the indebtedness of said
13 town.

SECT. 2. Said town is hereby authorized at the
2 annual meeting thereof to raise such sum of money
3 as they may determine for the purpose of the pay-
4 ment of such town orders or bonds as may be
5 issued under the provisions of this act.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
