STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to provide for Notice of Special Legislation for Protection of Fish.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of all persons

- 2 that are or may be benefited by legislation other
- 3 than the general statutes for the protection of fish
- 4 in any waters of this State, to publish such pro-
- 5 tection by posting and maintaining notices as
- 6 hereinafter provided. Said notices shall be placed
- 7 on the banks or shores of such protected waters,
- 8 not more than ten feet and not less than six feet
- 9 above the ground, in a conspicuous position; and
- 10 if on running water, such notices shall be not

- 11 more than one-half mile apart on the banks of such
- 12 water; and if on a pond or lake, not more than
- 13 one mile apart on the shores of such pond or lake.
 - Sect. 2. Said notices shall be painted on wood
 - 2 in black Roman letters not less than two inches in
 - 3 length and not less than one-half inch in breadth,
 - 4 so that such letters shall be plainly legible; and
 - 5 such notices shall state the number of the act and
 - 6 the date of same giving the said protection to such
 - 7 waters.
 - Sect. 3. Any one mutilating or destroying such
 - 2 notices, shall be subject to the same penalties as
 - 3 set forth in section twenty, chapter one hundred
 - 4 and twenty-seven of the Revised Statutes.
 - Sect. 4. In case no notices as herein provided are
 - 2 posted and maintained on waters that are pro-
 - 3 tected by special laws, then, no one violating such
 - 4 laws shall be liable thereunder to any penalties set
 - 5 forth in such laws.
