## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the Compensation of County Commissioners for Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Each County Commissioner for Oxford County

- 2 shall receive two dollars and fifty cents per day
- 3 while actually employed in the service of the
- 4 county, including the time spent in traveling, for
- 5 which he shall have eight cents a mile for the dis-
- 6 tance actually traveled; but he shall not have more
- 7 than one travel in the same hearing or session, nor
- 8 for more than two adjournments of any regular
- 9 term, nor for service or travel on more than one
- 10 petition or case at the same time, nor anything for

- 11 travel or attendance at the Legislature connected
- 12 with the annual county estimates, nor for any addi-
- 13 tional trouble or expense of any kind.
