STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of County Commissioners for Washington County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Each County Commissioner for Washington

- 2 County shall receive two dollars and fifty cents
- 3 per day while actually employed in the services of
- 4 the county, including the time spent in traveling,
- 5 for which he shall have ten cents a mile for the
- 6 distance actually traveled; but he shall not have
- 7 more than one travel in same hearing or session,
- 8 nor for more than two adjournments of any regular
- 9 term, nor for service or travel on more than one

- 10 petition or case at the same time, nor anything for
- 11 travel or attendance at the Legislature connected
- 12 with the annual county estimates, nor for any ad-
- 13 ditional trouble or expense of any kind.
