STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to make valid the doings of the Town of
Scarboro', in relation to the bridge of the Portland,
Saco and Portsmouth Railroad Company over Dun-
stan River in said town.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The action of the inhabitants of the town of Scarboro'
2 at their meeting held on the fifth day of March,
3 A. D. eighteen hundred and eighty-three, in em-
4 powering their Selectmen and Town Agent to
5 contract with the Portland, Saco and Portsmouth
6 Railroad Company, in relation to its bridge over
7 the Dunstan River in Scarboro', are made valid;
8 and the contract made by said Selectmen and

9 Town Agent in behalf of said town with said rail-
10 road company in relation to said bridge, dated the
11 twenty-first day of September, A. D. eighteen hun-
12 dred eighty-three, is hereby ratified and confirmed.
