STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to establish a standard weight for a Barrel of Potatoes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The standard weight of a barrel of
- 2 potatoes, in good order and fit for shipping, is one
- 3 hundred and sixty-five pounds.
 - SECT. 2. Whoever, acting for himself, or as the
- 2 employe of another, takes more than the standard
- 3 weight for a barrel of potatoes, shall forfeit fifty
- 4 cents for each barrel, to the person prosecuting
- 5 therefor within thirty days.
- Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
