STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to Scientific Temperance Instruction in Public Schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Provision shall be made by the pro-

- 2 per local school authorities for instructing all pupils
- 3 in all schools supported by public money or under
- 4 State control in physiology and hygiene with
- 5 special reference to the effects of alcoholic drinks,
- 6 stimulants and narcotics upon the human system.

SECT. 2. No certificate shall be granted any

- 2 person to teach in the public schools of their State
- 3 after the fourth day of July, eighteen hundred and
- 4 eighty-five, who has not passed a satisfactory ex-

- 5 amination in physiology and hygiene with special
- 6 reference to the effects of alcoholic drinks, stimu-
- 7 lants and narcotics upon the human system.
