## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter two hundred and three of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-three, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Portland Trust Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section two of chapter two hundred and three of

- 2 the private and special laws of eighteen hundred
- 3 and eighty-three is hereby amended by striking
- 4 out after the word "money" in the fifth line the
- 5 words "one-third of," so that said section as
- 6 amended may read as follows:
- 7 'Section 2. Said corporation shall at all times
- 8 have on hand in lawful money, as a reserve, not
- 9 less than twenty-five per centum of the aggregate

- 10 amount of all its deposits, which are subject to
- 11 withdrawal on demand; provided, in lieu of lawful
- 12 money said twenty-five per centum may consist of
- 13 balances, payable on demand, due from any
- 14 National or State banks.'
