STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT additional to "An Act to authorize Lewis Leadbetter, Jr., and Elisha C. Cooper to build a bridge over tide waters in the town of North Haven," being chapter 191 of Private and Special Laws of 1879.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter one hundred and ninety-one 2 of the private and special laws of the year one 3 thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine is hereby 4 amended by adding thereto the following words: 5 "provided said bridge have a space under the same 6 not less than twelve feet wide between the abutments 7 thereof, and of sufficient height to give a free

- 8 passage of said width under said bridge for the navi-
- 9 gation of said tide waters by boats."
- Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on its ap-2 proval by the governor.
