STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and ninety
of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hun-
dred and eighty, relating to the compensation of
Claim Agent.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section first of chapter two hundred
2 and ninety of the private and special laws of
3 eighteen hundred and eighty is hereby amended
4 by inserting after the words "United States," in
5 the sixth line of said section, the words 'excepting
6 claims of the State arising from and on account of
7 war taxes, under acts of Congress in the years
8 eighteen hundred and sixty-one and eighteen hun-

9 dred and sixty-two,' so that the whole section as
10 amended shall read :

'SECT. 1. The treasurer of the State of Maine
12 is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to
13 pay to the agent of said State, duly appointed and
14 authorized by the governor to prosecute to final
15 decision in the departments at Washington any
16 and all unadjusted claims, of every nature, of said
17 State against the United States, excepting claims
18 of the State arising from and on account of war
19 taxes, under act of Congress in the years eighteen
20 hundred and sixty-one and eighteen hundred and
21 sixty-two, as compensation for his services and for
22 expenses of every kind, fifteen per cent out of all
23 the money or moneys received by the State as
24 contemplated by this act, to be paid to the treasurer
25 as fast as such claims shall be collected; the re-
26 mainder of the money or moneys so received shall
27 be covered into the State treasury by the treasurer;
28 *provided*, that no money or moneys secured to the
29 State in pursuance of this act shall be paid to
30 said agent by the United States, but the same shall
31 be paid to the State treasurer and by him disposed
32 of as aforesaid.
