STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT additional to and amendatory of chapter two hundred and sixty-seven of the Special Laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The time named in section one,

- 2 chapter two hundred and sixty-seven of the Special
- 3 Laws of the year one thousand eight hundred
- 4 and eighty, for completing the railroad mentioned
- 5 in said act is hereby extended for a further period
- 6 of four years from and after the approval of this
- 7 act, and the provisions of said chapter two hundred
- 8 and sixty-seven, except so far as modified by this
- 9 act, are hereby revived and continued in force.

SECT. 2. Section one of chapter two hundred 2 and sixty-seven of the Special Laws of the year 3 one thousand eight hundred and eighty, is hereby 4 amended by striking out in the eighth line thereof 5 the word "Bridgton," and inserting therein in lieu 6 thereof the words 'Standish or Windham, near the 7 outlet of Sebago Lake.'
