STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend "An Act to incorporate the Harrison Mutual Fire Insurance Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter two hundred and eighty-

- 2 seven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen
- 3 hundred and fifty-nine is hereby amended so as to
- 4 read as follows:

12 Sampson, and all others who may hereafter become 13 members of said company, in manner herein pre-14 scribed, are hereby incorporated and made a body 15 politic, by the name of the Harrison Mutual Fire 16 Insurance Company, for the purpose of insuring, 17 in the town of Harrison only; provided, however, 18 if the company so vote, they shall have the right 19 to insure, in the manner hereafter described, in the 20 town of Otisfield also, their respective dwelling-21 houses, stores, shops, barns and other buildings, 22 household furniture, merchandise and other pro-23 perty, against loss or damage by fire, whether the 24 same happen by accident, lightning, or by any 25 other means, excepting that of design in the in-26 sured; and may purchase and hold such real and 27 personal estate as may be necessary to effect the 28 object of this association, and may sell and convey 29 the same at pleasure.
