IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to set off a portion of the town of Weston,
in the county of Aroostook, and annex the same
to the town of Danforth, in the county of Wash-
ington.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

All that portion of the town of Weston, in the
2 county of Aroostook, lying west or south-west of
3 Baskehegan Stream, so called, is hereby set off, and
4 the same is annexed to the town of Danforth, in the
5 county of Washington.
