## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to set off a portion of the town of Weston, in the county of Aroostook, and annex the same to the town of Danforth, in the county of Washington.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

All that portion of the town of Weston, in the

- 2 county of Aroostook, lying west or south-west of
- 3 Baskehegan Stream, so called, is hereby set off, and
- 4 the same is annexed to the town of Danforth, in the
- 5 county of Washington.
