## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the time for Monson Hotel Company to navigate Lake Hebron.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The Monson Hotel Company, its successors and

- 2 assigns shall have a further time of two years
- 3 from January first, eingteen hundred and eighty-
- 4 five, within which to navigate Lake Hebron, other-
- 5 wise known as Hebron Pond, in the town of Mon-
- 6 son, in accordance with the provisions of chapter
- 7 one hundred and ninety-one of the private and
- 8 special laws of Maine for eighteen hundred and
- 9 eighty-three.
