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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-FIVE.

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AN ACT to repeal an act entitled "An Act to incor-  
porate the Town of Kingsbury."

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The act entitled "An act to incor-  
2 porate the town of Kingsbury," approved March  
3 twenty-second, eighteen hundred and thirty-six,  
4 being chapter one hundred and forty-six of the  
5 Special Laws of Maine of the year eighteen hun-  
6 dred and thirty-six, is hereby repealed; *provided,*  
7 *however,* that the corporate existence, powers,  
8 duties and liabilities of said town shall survive for  
9 the purpose of prosecuting and defending all  
10 pending suits and causes of suits to which said

11 town is, or may be a party, and all claims and de-  
12 mands subsisting in favor of or against said town,  
13 and all needful processes growing out of the same  
14 and for the further purpose of providing for pay-  
15 ment of any judgment which may be recovered  
16 against said town.

SECT. 2. The provisions of this act shall apply  
2 to any school district in said town so far as the  
3 same is applicable.
