STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for the protection of the sea and shore fisheries and shell fish for the years eighteen hundred and eighty-five and eighteen hundred and eighty-six.

Resolved, That the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated for each of the years of eighteen hundred and eighty-five and eighteen hundred and eighty-six, to be expended by the commissioners of sea and shore fisheries and shell fish, under the direction of the governor and council.
