STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of the Dairying, Beef-Raising and Mutton-Growing Interests of the State of Maine.

Resolved, That the sum of two thousand dollars 2 be and hereby is appropriated for the Maine State 3 Agricultural Society, and two thousand dollars for 4 the Eastern Maine State Fair, of which there shall 5 be paid the sum of one thousand dollars to each of 6 said societies during the year one thousand eight 7 hundred and eighty-five, and one thousand dollars 8 to each of said societies during the year one thougand eight hundred and eighty-six. Four hundred 10 dollars of said appropriation shall be used annually 11 by each society, for the purpose of encouraging 12 the dairying interests in this State. Four hundred 13 dollars for the purpose of encouraging the raising 14 of beef and fat cattle in this State, and two hun- 15 dred dollars for the purpose of encouraging mutton

16 growing in this State. These several sums shall 17 be offered by the two said societies in premiums to

18 be competed for by the citizens of this State.

19 list for the premiums shall be arranged jointly by

20 the executive officers of the two said societies,

21 together with the President and Secretary of the

22 Board of Agriculture.
