STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section nineteen, chapter one hundred and thirty-four, Revised Statues, providing for taking depositions in criminal cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section nineteen, chapter one hundred and thirty-

- 2 four of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by
- 3 adding to the end of said section the following
- 4 words, viz: 'And upon like application by the
- 5 defendant in a criminal case a like commission may
- 6 issue to take the deposition of a material witness
- 7 living in the State; but the prosecuting officer
- 8 shall not name therein any material witness to
- 9 be examined on the part of the State.
