EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section nineteen, chapter one  
hundred and thirty-four, Revised Statutes, providing  
for taking depositions in criminal cases.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section nineteen, chapter one hundred and thirty-  
2 four of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by  
3 adding to the end of said section the following  
4 words, viz: 'And upon like application by the  
5 defendant in a criminal case a like commission may  
6 issue to take the deposition of a material witness  
7 living in the State; but the prosecuting officer  
8 shall not name therein any material witness to  
9 be examined on the part of the State.
