RESOLVE in favor of State Normal Schools.

Resolved, That for repairs and improvements of

- 2 the buildings and grounds of the three normal
- 3 schools established and maintained by the State,
- 4 there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of
- 5 fifteen hundred dollars for the year eighteen hun-
- 6 dred and eighty-five, and the like sum of fifteen
- 7 hundred dollars for the year eighteen hundred and
- 8 eighty-six, the same to be expended under the
- 9 direction of the trustees of normal schools.


