STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT in relation to the election of Selectmen.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

At their annual meeting in March, eighteen hun2 dred and eighty-six, towns shall, by a major vote,
3 choose three only of their inhabitants to be select4 men. At their first meeting the board thus chosen
5 shall designate by lot one of their number to hold
6 office three years and another two years, and cer7 tify such designation to the town clerk, who shall
8 make a record thereof. The third member shall
9 hold office one year, and each member chosen to
10 fill the place of one whose term expires shall hold
11 office three years. In case of a vacancy by death

12 or resignation of any member of the board the

13 town shall at its annual meeting or any special14 meeting legally called for the purpose choose one15 of its inhabitants to fill the vacancy thus occasioned

16 during the remainder of the term.
