Resolved, That the State Treasurer is hereby

- 4 cents for one cow and one steer, killed by order
- 5 of the selectmen of said town of Monson, after
- 6 having been appraised by three disinterested men,
- 7 said animals having been pronounced sick with
- 8 lung-murrain, a contagious disease.
