STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to Skating Rinks.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Every person who keeps a roller
2 skating rink or room shall obtain a license from
3 the municipal officers of the city or town where
4 such rink is located, and shall pay therefor such
5 sums as said municipal officers may deem proper.
6 Any person keeping a roller skating rink without
7 such license shall be fined ten dollars for each day
8 it is so kept, to be recovered by complaint, indict-
9 ment, or action of debt to the use of the prose-
10 cutor.

SECT. 2. Every person so licensed shall keep
2 such rink closed between ten o'clock in the evening

3 and sunrise, unless express permission in writing
4 to keep it open a longer time is obtained from the
5 municipal officers of the city or town where such
6 rink is located. Any person violating this section
7 shall be fined ten dollars for every such offence, to
8 be recovered as provided in the preceding section.
