AN ACT to facilitate the prompt administration of  
justice, by establishing a third term of the Supreme  
Judicial Court, in the County of Aroostook.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section forty-seven of chapter  
2 seventy-seven of the Revised Statutes is hereby  
3 amended by adding after the word “September” in  
4 the tenth line thereof the following: ‘and at Cari-  
5 bou for the transaction of civil business on the  
6 first Tuesday of August,’ so that the third clause  
7 of said section as amended shall read as follows:

SECT. 2. ‘Aroostook, at Houlton, on the last  
2 Tuesday of February, and the third Tuesday of

3 September, and at Caribou for the transaction of  
4 civil business, on the first Tuesday of August.'

SECT. 3. The town of Caribou shall furnish  
2 proper and convenient rooms and accommodations  
3 for the use of the court to be held in that town and  
4 a proper place for the confinement of prisoners  
5 during such terms, free from expense to the county  
6 of Aroostook, and until said rooms and accommo-  
7 dations be so furnished, said courts shall be held in  
8 Houlton.
