AN ACT requiring notice of Application for Probate of Wills.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Whenever a will is presented for probate the

- 2 judge of probate having jurisdiction thereof shall
- 3 assign a time and place for a hearing, and cause
- 4 public notice thereof to be given, and in addition
- 5 thereto said judge may, at his discretion, order
- 6 personal notice upon such persons as he deems
- 7 necessary.
