STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize Gershom F. Burgess to build
and maintain bridge across Goose River, at Rock-
port, in the town of Camden.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled as follows:*

SECTION 1. Gershom F. Burgess of Camden, his
2 heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized and em-
3 powered to build and maintain at the head of navi-
4 gation in Rockport harbor, in said Camden, a bridge
5 twenty feet wide and extending thirty feet across
6 Goose river upon his own land, just south of the
7 iron bridge across said river; *provided*, said bridge
8 is so constructed as not to interfere or obstruct
9 navigation.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved by the governor.
