STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter twenty-four of the Re-
vised Statutes, relating to Paupers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section thirty of chapter twenty-four
2 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by in-
3 serting after the word "place," in the first line of
4 said section, the words 'or in a place beyond the
5 limits of the State,' so that said section, as amend-
6 ed, shall read as follows:

'SECT. 30. When persons residing in an unin-
8 corporated place, or in a place beyond the limits of
9 the State, and having no pauper settlement in the
10 State, remove from such place to any town in which

11 they have never resided before such removal, and
12 there need relief, and the same is furnished to them
13 by such town, the State shall re-imburse said town
14 for such relief so furnished, in the same manner
15 and under the same restrictions, as to the amount
16 re-imbursed, as provided in the preceding section.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
