STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of State Prison.

Resolved, That the sum of seven thousand seven 2 hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated for 3 the benefit of the State Prison, to be divided as 4 follows: Five thousand five hundred dollars for the 5 building of a blacksmith shop, to be built under 6 the supervision of the warden and inspectors of 7 prisons, and two thousand dollars for repairs on 8 prison buildings, one thousand of which is to be 9 expended in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-10 five, and the other thousand in the year eighteen 11 hundred and eighty-six; and two hundred dollars 12 for the prison library—one hundred of which is to 13 be expended in the year eighteen hundred and

14 eighty-five, and one hundred in the year eighteen 15 hundred and eighty-six. The last two named sums 16 are to be expended under the direction of the 17 warden.
