STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to exempt certain Plantations from paying State and County Taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled as follows:

SECTION 1. The plantations of Chapman, Glen-

- 2 wood, Macwahoc, Mars, Oxford, Portage Lake,
- 3 Reed, Wade, Westfield, Coplin, Dallas, Greenvale,
- 4 Letter E, Perkins, Rangeley, Long Island, No. 7,
- 5 Franklin, Lincoln, Drew, Lakeville, No. 2, Grand
- 6 Falls, Stacyville, Webster, Carrying-Place, Dead
- 7 River, Flag Staff, Highland, Codyville, No. 14,
- 8 E. D., No. 21, shall be exempt from paying State
- 9 and county taxes except as provided for taxing

- 10 plantations containing less than two hundred 11 inhabitants.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
