STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVES relating to the Taxation of Timber and Grass on the Reserved Lands of the State.

Resolved, That the Governor and Council are 2 hereby required to make a valuation of the timber 3 and grass on the reserved lands in the several 4 townships and tracts of land, in the State, where 5 said timber and grass have been sold and conveyed 6 by deed with all other interest conveyed thereby. 7 Said valuation to be made for the purpose of taxa-8 tion. Said tax to be assessed at the same rate as 9 State and county taxes are now assessed upon 10 other property in the State.

Resolved, That the Land Agent is hereby re-12 quired to furnish for the Governor and Council 13 a schedule of all such reserved lands whereon the 14 timber and grass have been sold and conveyed by 15 deed, showing the townships and number of acres16 in each township so sold.
