STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend and make clear section 63 of the Revised Statutes, relating to Fish Weirs on the Sea Shore.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 63 of chapter 3 of the Revised Statutes

- 2 shall be amended as follows, viz: That the words
- 3 'or maintained' shall be inserted after the word
- 4 "erected" in the third line, the words 'for each
- 5 offence' after the word "dollars" in the fourth line,
- 6 and the words 'all acts or parts of acts inconsistent
- 7 with this act are hereby repealed' shall be added
- 8 at the end of the last line, so that this section when
- 9 amended shall read as follows:

'SECT. 2. No fish weir or wharf shall be extended, 11 erected or maintained except in accordance with 12 this chapter; and no fish weir shall be erected or 13 maintained in tide waters below low water mark in 14 front of the shore or flats of another, without the 15 owner's consent, under a penalty of fifty dollars for 16 each offence, to be recovered in an action of debt 17 by the owner of said shore or flats; but this chapter 18 does not apply to weirs the materials of which are 19 chiefly removed annually, provided, that they do 20 not obstruct navigation, nor interfere with the 21 rights of others. All acts or parts of acts incon-22 sistent with this act are hereby repealed.'
