STATE OF MAINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter eighty of the Special
Laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter eighty of
2 the special laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-
3 eight is hereby amended by adding after the last
4 word in said section the following words: 'Or by
5 action of debt before any court having competent
6 jurisdiction, to the benefit of the person suing
7 therefor,' so that said section as amended shall read
8 as follows: 'All the penalties under the provisions
9 of the foregoing sections shall be recovered by
10 complaint or indictment before any court having
11 jurisdiction in like offenses or by action of debt

12 before any court having competent jurisdiction, to
13 the benefit of the person suing therefor.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved,
