AN ACT to provide for Recording Deeds made by the State of Maine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled as follows:

Any person interested in any land conveyed by

3 in the Land Agent's office, may cause a copy,

2 the State of Maine, the deed of which is recorded

- 4 attested by the Land Agent, to be filed and
- 5 recorded in the registry of deeds in the county
- 6 and registry district where said land lies, whether
- 7 said deed shall or not have been acknowledged by
- 8 the Agent or other person making the same; and
- 9 such record shall have all the force and effect of
- 10 a record of deeds duly acknowledged.
