STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section forty-one of chapter
ninety-one of the Revised Statutes, relative to liens
on animals for pasturage, food and shelter.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section forty-one of chapter ninety-
2 one of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by
3 striking out all of the words in the fifth line of said
4 section, and inserting in place thereof the words, 'in
5 possession and choses in action.' So that said sec-
6 tion as amended shall read as follows:

'SECT. 41. Whoever pastures, feeds, or shelters
8 animals by virtue of a contract with or by consent
9 of the owner, has a lien thereon for the amount

10 due for such pasturing, feeding or sheltering, to
11 secure payment thereof with costs, to be enforced
12 in the same manner as liens on goods in possession
13 and choses in action.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
