STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize Henry H. Page to navigate
the Lower Lakes on the West Branch of Penobscot
River by steam.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Henry H. Page his associates and
2 assigns are hereby vested with the exclusive right
3 of employing and navigating every kind of boat
4 or water craft propelled by steam for him or as
5 common carrier on the Lower Lakes of the West
6 Branch of Penobscot River, to wit: Pamadumcook
7 North Twin, South Twin and Ambejjus lakes, all

8 connected and situated in Penobscot and Aroos-
9 took counties with full power to construct locks,
10 piers and wharves for the term of twenty years
11 from the approval of this act.

SECT. 2. A reasonable toll is hereby authorized
2 for transportation of persons and merchandise and
3 for towing logs on and across said lakes, the rates
4 to be established by the County Commissioners of
5 Penobscot County from time to time as they may
6 determine.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.

To the Honorable House and Senate of Maine in Legislature assembled.

The undersigned respectfully prays your honorable bodies to grant a charter to him and his assigns with exclusive rights for twenty years, to navigate by steam the Lower Lakes, so called, on the West Branch of Penobscot River, to wit: Pamadumcook, North Twin, South Twin and Ambejjus lakes, with the right to construct locks and wharves for the accommodation of steam vessels.
