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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend section forty-six, chapter thirty-eight of the Revised Statutes, relating to the Measure of Milk.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section forty-six of chapter thirty-two eight, Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by striking out the words "ale and beer," in said section, and inserting instead thereof the word 'wine,' so that said section, when amended, shall read as follows:

SECT. 2. 'All measures, cans, or other vessels used in the sale of milk, shall annually be sealed

3 by the sealer of weights and measures by wine  
4 measure, and shall be marked by the sealer, with  
5 figures indicating the quantity which they hold,  
6 and whoever fraudulently sells by any other meas-  
7 ure, can or vessel forfeits twenty dollars for each  
8 offence.
