STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to create a Lien on Last Blocks.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Whoever labors in the manufacturing of last
2 blocks or cuts, or furnishes wood for the manu-
3 facture of the same, or is engaged in cooking for
4 persons engaged in such labor or furnishes a team
5 for the hauling of said last blocks or the lumber
6 from which they are manufactured, has a lien on
7 said last blocks for the amount due him for his
8 personal labor thereon, or that of his team and for
9 the amount due for wood so cut or furnished, which
10 takes precedence of all other claims except liens

11 reserved to the State; said lien shall continue for
12 thirty days after the said last blocks are stored or
13 housed for drying purposes, and shall be enforced
14 by attachment.
