STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to prevent persons from unlawfully using
or wearing the badge of the Grand Army of the
Republic of this State.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Any person who shall wilfully wear the badge of
2 the Grand Army of the Republic, or who shall use
3 or wear the same to obtain aid or assistance there-
4 by within this State, unless he shall be entitled to
5 use or wear the same under the Rules and Regula-
6 tions of the Department of Maine Grand Army of
7 the Republic, shall be guilty of misdemeanor, and
8 upon conviction shall be punished by imprisonment
9 for a term not to exceed thirty days in the county

10 jail, or a fine not to exceed twenty dollars, or by
11 both such fine and imprisonment.
