RESOLVE in favor of the town of Frenchville, in  
Aroostook County.

---

*Resolved,* That there be and is hereby appropri-  
2 ated the sum of three hundred dollars to be ex-  
3 pended under direction of an agent to be appointed  
4 by the Governor and Council, in removing a  
5 dangerous ledge in the highway near St. John  
6 River, in Frenchville, Aroostook County.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The road through the town of Frenchville passes at a certain point for a considerable distance between the St. John River and a high ledge of rock, and the passage is narrow, and especially in winter is quite dangerous to pass over, and there is no way to go around it.

The only way to improve the road is by cutting away and removing a portion of said ledge, which would be quite an expensive task and beyond the means of this town to do; the cost of which is estimated at \$1200.
